ways to manage your pups discomfort...

Protect the Paws



- Wipe paws after walks
- Use paw balm or booties
- Avoid heavily salted areas

Support From the Inside

- Omega-3s for skin & coat health
- Probiotics for gut & immune support
- Remove food allergens from diet

Reduce Indoor Allergens

- Wash bedding weekly (fragrance-free detergent)
- Vacuum carpets, furniture, and rugs
- Wash blankets and plush toys often
- Make the switch to flameless candles



When to call the Vet...

If symptoms are persistent, worsening, or causing discomfort, consult your veterinarian to rule out infections or other underlying conditions.

Common Triggers

- Dry indoor air & low humidity
- Dust mites, mold, and indoor allergens
- Road salt & ice melt on paws
- Over-bathing that strips natural oils
